WHEREAS, the rates of compensation for off-duty city police officers is required to be established by Ordinance pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-8.6; and

WHEREAS, the Trenton Police Department is also permitted to charge an administrative fee for costs associated with the contracting of city police officers for off-duty employment pursuant to this section; and

WHEREAS, the City has established such rates at Section 2-58.2E of its Code, but it has not modified the rates since 2011; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached to simplify and unify the compensation rates for the off-duty, outside employment of City police officers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton desires to amend Chapter 2, Article XII, Section 58.2 of the Code of the City of Trenton to modify the rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty police officers to be in line with the surrounding municipalities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 2 Article XII ("Police Department") of the Code of the City of Trenton is hereby amended as follows (additions are <u>underlined</u> and deletions are <u>struck through</u>).

§§ 2-56 through 2-58.1: No change.

§ 2-58.2

Subsections A through D: No change.

§ 2-58.2E. Rates of compensation; administrative fees; payment for services. Rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty City police officers shall take effect on January 1, 2011 shall be as follows:

- (1) For all security and non-construction traffic control assignments, the rate shall be as follows:
- (a) Rate categories and descriptions.
 - [1] Low or medium risk security: \$30 \$40 per hour.
 - [a] Security assignments that have a low to medium probability of police involvement

- (c) The Police Director or designee shall determine which security rate applies for the person or entity wishing to employ off-duty police officers.
 - (2) For all exterior security at licensed liquor establishments, and for any sporting/entertainment arenas with a seating capacity over 2,000, requiring officers to provide interior/exterior security/traffic control, the rate shall be \$55 \underset 65 per hour.
 - (3) For construction traffic control assignments contracted by the City of Trenton with private companies, the rate shall be \$57.20 \sum 885 per hour.
 - (4) For non-City-contracted construction traffic control assignments, the rate shall be \$65 \$85 per hour.
 - (5) In addition to the hourly rate, an administrative fee of 14% shall be applied to all hourly rates.
 - (6) In the event that a party or employer employs any off-duty City police officer pursuant to this section, in addition to any compensation to be paid to the City pursuant to the requirements herein, there shall also be a fee of \$10 per hour per vehicle for the use of marked police vehicles.
 - (7) Periodic special events such as parades, festivals, etc., shall be compensated under the regular overtime rates.

(8) Rates of compensation shall be reviewed on a yearly basis for any contractual or other increases.

§ 2-58.2F: No change.

Section 2. Repealer.

Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause or other provision of the Code of the City of Trenton inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

WHEREAS, there is within the City of Trenton certain city-owned real property located at 101 Homan Avenue, designated as Block 33704, Lot 1 on the City of Trenton Tax Map (hereinafter, the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is a small irregular shaped lot that has been unused and city owned since October/1985, does not meet the minimum lot size requirements for development under the municipal zoning ordinance, and thereby, does not allow for any other viable use other than a side lot for the contiguous property (See image, appended hereto as "Exhibit A"; and

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRENTON REQUIRING THE COUNCIL TO CONVENE IN A RETREAT WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS AFTER THE REORGANIZATION FOLLOWING EACH TRENTON MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trenton recognizes the importance of effective governance, collaboration, and strategic planning for the benefit of the city and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that a retreat following each election is an essential opportunity for newly elected and returning members to engage in strategic discussions, establish goals, and build a collaborative working relationship; and

WHEREAS, a Council retreat provides an environment conducive to open dialogue, the sharing of ideas, and the planning of the Council's legislative agenda for the upcoming term; and

WHEREAS, such a retreat will enhance the ability of the City Council to function as an effective legislative body that serves the best interests of the City of Trenton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

This ordinance mandates that the City Council of the City of Trenton convene in a retreat within sixty (60) days following the reorganization of the Council after each election.

Section 2. Retreat Requirement

- A. The City Council shall convene in a retreat within sixty (60) days after the reorganization meeting, following each municipal election in which new Council members are elected or incumbents are re-elected.
- B. The purpose of the retreat shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - 1. Setting legislative priorities for the term.
 - 2. Engaging in team-building exercises to strengthen working relationships among Council members.
 - 3. Reviewing and discussing best practices in governance, ethics, and transparency.
 - 4. Establishing processes and norms for effective communication and collaboration within the Council.
 - 5. Reviewing the strategic goals and objectives for the City of Trenton.

C. The retreat shall be facilitated by a qualified external facilitator, selected by the City Council, who is experienced in municipal governance, strategic planning, and leadership development.

Section 3. Location & Duration

A. The retreat may be held at a location inside or outside the City of Trenton, as deemed appropriate by the Council, provided that the location is conducive to the objectives set forth in this ordinance.

B. The duration of the retreat shall be no less than one full working day (8 hours) and may extend longer as determined by the Council.

Section 4. Public Notice and Transparency

- A. While the retreat is intended as a workshop for Council members, it shall comply with the requirements of New Jersey's Open Public Meetings Act (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.) to ensure transparency and public accountability.
- B. A summary of the discussions, objectives, and outcomes from the retreat shall be made available to the public following the conclusion of the retreat, unless otherwise restricted by law.

Section 5. Funding

In complying with guidance from the State of NJ Department of Community Affairs representative, the costs associated with the retreat, including but not limited to venue fees, facilitator fees, and any necessary materials, shall be provided for within the City Council's annual budget. The budget line item for this expenditure shall be set at a minimum of \$25,000.

Section 6. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR S1622/A4042 AUTHORIZING THE USE OF RANK CHOICE VOTING IN MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton ("Trenton") is governed by the Mayor-Council Plan C of Government under the Optional Municipal Charter Law of 1950, more commonly known as the Faulkner Act, N.J.S.A. 40:69A-1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:69A-34.1(b), Trenton previously opted to hold its regular, municipal elections on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November, subject to the Uniform Nonpartisan Law, N.J.S.A. 40:45-5 et. seq., to require run-offs if no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:45-18; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:45-19 mandates that run-off elections must occur on the subsequent Tuesday after the first Monday in December; and

WHEREAS, no additional options, such as the use of Ranked Choice Voting to enable the holding of an "instant run-off" election, are currently legal permitted in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Ranked Choice Voting ("RCV") is a simple upgrade to the way Trenton voters currently vote, and enables votes to rank candidates in the order of preference and ensures that winners of any election have the support of – and are accountable to – a majority of voters; and

WHEREAS, RCV in its most common form is a majority runoff for single winner races where votes are transferred from the lowest ranked candidate up to higher ranked candidates until one person achieves 50% plus of the votes cast, which method of counting is known as the "Instant Run-off," and

WHEREAS, there is also a proportional version of RCV often used for multi-winner races like those held for at-large Council Members of the City Council, Trenton's school board and its two General Assembly seats. In this version of RCV, know as "Single Transferable Vote," each candidate that receives the necessary threshold number of votes (that vary with the number of seats elected) is elected. All votes in excess of that threshold of any elected candidate are then transferred o the voters next preferred candidate on a proportional basis. Subsequently, votes are transferred from the lowest ranked candidate up to higher ranked candidates until another candidate achieves the threshold number of votes. This process continues until all seats are filled.

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to give the voters of Trenton the opportunity to adopt RCV to elect the Mayor, Council members and School Board members once the state law is changes to permit such method of voting; and

WHEREAS, the passage of pending legislation 51622/A4042 would provide Trenton with the option of adopting RCV; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESLOVED that;

- 1. The City hereby expresses its support for S1622/A.4042, legislation, if enacted would enable the City of Trenton to adopt RCV for its municipal and school board elections, if approved by the voters; and
- 2. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Legislative Delegation representing Trenton with an urging that such legislation be passed as soon as possible; and
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect pursuant to law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$200,000.00 FROM THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE CITY OF TRENTON UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 TO ROJO'S TRENTON LLC

WHEREAS, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA-21) into law on March 11, 2021, and thereby sought to provide immediate and emergent aid to metropolitan cities adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury (DOT) has stated that, "From big cities to small towns, Americans – particularly people of color, immigrants, and low-wage workers – are facing a deep economic crisis"; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CSLFRF) established by ARPA-21 provide \$72,913,998.00 in aid to the City of Trenton over the next two years, with \$36,456,999 having been distributed for the 2021 calendar year and \$36,456,999.00 to be distributed for the 2022 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Final Rule for the CSLFRF promulgated by the DOT (Final Rule) authorizes "the use of payments from the Fiscal Recovery Funds to respond to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 or its negative economic impacts"; and

WHEREAS, the Final Rule generally includes as an eligible use of ARPA-21 funds "Small Business Economic Assistance (Expenditure Category (EC) 2.9) and more specifically articulates that such assistance includes rehabilitation of Commercial properties or other improvements (EC 2.31) and enhanced support to microbusinesses (EC 2.33); and

WHEREAS, the DOT has emphasized the money is designed to provide "immediate and direct relief" and "substantial flexibility for each government to meet local needs"; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic exacerbated existing disparities in venture capital investments, with Black founders seeing venture capital funding decrease by 45%, compared to the 36% drop overall; and

WHEREAS, in April 2024, the Starbucks Community Store located at 102 South Warren Street in Trenton closed its doors, leaving a void in Trenton's downtown landscape and dealing a significant blow to the progress the City has made in fostering a more equitable and vibrant city; and

WHEREAS, Joanne Canady-Brown, a female minority of African-American descent, is the owner and head baker at the Gingered Peach, a nationally recognized bakery, and Melba Ice Creamery, both located in Lawrence, New Jersey, and Rojo's Roastery, a small-batch, artisan coffee roaster located in Princeton, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Canady-Brown is also a social activist, raising awareness regarding food insecurity and economic inequity, and who has regularly donated unsold baked good to the Trenton Areas Soup Kitchen (TASK) for years; and

WHEREAS, in addition to her talents as a baker and entrepreneur, Ms. Canady-Brown's civic activities have earned her several accolades—among them, the Liz Erickson Impact Award from NonProfitConnect (a Mercer County organization which encourages board and staff diversity) and a fellowship in the James Beard Foundation's women's entrepreneurial leadership program; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Canady-Brown will be relocating and expanding Gingered Peach's bakery production and Rojo's Roastery flagship roastery and café to the former Starbuck's location in Trenton, resulting in the creation of jobs in Trenton and revitalization of a key business location in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the relocation and expansion of the baking and roasting operations will require the purchase and installation of new and larger equipment, including a roaster, mixer, refrigerator and oven, all at a cost of over \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Canady-Brown has arranged for \$300,000 of funding for the needed improvements, but still needs \$200,000 to finance the equipment upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the relocation of the Gingered Peach's bakery production and establishment of Rojo's Roaster flagship roastery at 102 South Warren Street will benefit the City of Trenton and its residents by filling the void left by Starbucks' departure and creating job opportunities and learned baking skills for residents, but also putting a spotlight on entrepreneurship in Trenton and attracting quality entrepreneurs who are focused on economic development in Trenton, as well as assuring a steady stream of commerce with sales of coffee and baked goods; and

WHEREAS, Rojo's Trenton will be required to sign a grant agreement as a condition of receiving the ARPA-21 funds and abide by the conditions of the grant agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Trenton that ARPA-21 funds not to exceed the amount of \$200,000.00 shall be appropriated to Rojo's Trenton on a *reimbursement basis* for eligible costs incurred, subject to Rojo's Trenton:

- 1) Complying with all laws, contractual requirements, guidelines, and agreements;
- 2) Completing projects in accordance with the approved scope of work and agreed upon timeline; and

WHEREAS, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA-21) into law on March 11, 2021, and thereby sought to provide immediate and emergent aid to metropolitan cities adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury (DOT) has stated that, "From big cities to small towns, Americans – particularly people of color, immigrants, and low-wage workers – are facing a deep economic crisis"; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CSLFRF) established by ARPA-21 provide \$72,913,998.00 in aid to the City of Trenton over the next two years, with \$36,456,999 having been distributed for the 2021 calendar year and \$36,456,999.00 to be distributed for the 2022 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Final Rule for the CSLFRF promulgated by the DOT (Final Rule) authorizes "the use of payments from the Fiscal Recovery Funds to respond to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 or its negative economic impacts"; and

WHEREAS, the Final Rule generally includes as an eligible use of ARPA-21 funds assistance to not-for-profit entities (Expenditure Category (EC) 2.34) and specifically for Healthy Childhood Environments (EC 2.14), Strong Healthy Communities (EC 2.22), and Addressing Educational Disparities (academic, social, emotional) (EC 2.25); and

WHEREAS, the DOT has emphasized the money is designed to provide "immediate and direct relief" and "substantial flexibility for each government to meet local needs"; and

WHEREAS, in July 2022, the City of Trenton introduced a fund totaling \$2,000,000 to extend the opportunity for ARP funding to certified 501(c)(3), not-for-profit organizations who either operate in Trenton or serve Trenton residents (subrecipient program); and

WHEREAS, the DOT Final Rule includes as an eligible use of ARPA-21 funds "A program, service, capital expenditure, or other assistance that is provided to a disproportionately impacted household, population, or

community, including . . . [i]nvestments in communities to promote improved health outcomes and public safety"; and

WHEREAS, The Interfaith Tabernacle Church is a certified 501(c)(3) non-for-profit organization, which has provided a space for worship and community outreach in the surrounding Trenton area through food assistance, overnight stay, and counseling programs for anyone seeking refuge or relief; and

WHEREAS, The Interfaith Tabernacle Church seeks a \$48,000.00 grant for the purpose of repairing the whole of their Church roof due to the many holes, cracks, and other decays that has led to interior damage from the leaking rain. The issue has permeated into a safety hazard, and if it is not addressed soon, it holds the risk of collapsing inward into the sanctuary which would halt the operations of the Church and their programs; and

WHEREAS, The Interfaith Tabernacle Church has submitted the required documentation, and its proposal has received a score of 98 from the Proposal Review Team, making it eligible for consideration by City Council; and

WHEREAS, The Interfaith Tabernacle Church will be required to sign a grant agreement as a condition of receiving the ARPA-21 funds and abide by the conditions of the grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, this City Council agrees that the project funding sought by The Interfaith Tabernacle Church is consistent with the goals of the City's Subrecipient Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Trenton that ARPA-21 funds not to exceed the amount of \$48,000.00 shall be appropriated to The Interfaith Tabernacle Church on a *reimbursement basis* for eligible costs incurred, subject to The Interfaith Tabernacle Church:

WHEREAS, Rowan Preservation LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Sponsor") proposes to rehabilitate Rowan Towers, a single, 15-story tower comprised of 196 units of affordable housing located in the City of Trenton ("City") that houses approximately 800 residents (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency Law of 1983, as amended (N.J.S.A. 55:14K-1, et seq.) and the rules promulgated thereunder at N.J.A.C. 5:80-1.1, et seq., and all applicable guidelines promulgated thereunder (the foregoing collectively referred to as the "HMFA Requirements") on a site described as Lot 3, Block 2604 as shown on the Official Assessment Map of the City of Trenton, County of Mercer, and commonly known as the Rowan Towers multifamily housing project, 620 West State Street, Trenton, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Project, if approved by the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency ("HMFA") will be subject to the HMFA Requirements, and the mortgage and other loan documents executed between the Sponsor and HMFA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the HMFA Requirements, the governing body of the City must adopt a resolution approving a renewed agreement for Payment in Lieu of Taxes ("PILOT") between the City and the Sponsor to secure HMFA financing that will take effect upon the expiration of the current agreement for Payment in Lieu of Taxes between the City and the Sponsor; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsor, in its request for a PILOT agreement between the City and the Sponsor to secure HMFA financing, has presented to the City a revenue projection for the Project that sets forth the annual anticipated revenue to be received by the Sponsor from the operation of the Project as Estimated by the Sponsor and HMFA, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City, after reviewing the relevant financials associated with the Project, and noting that a 6.28 percent rate is recommended by HMFA, deems the recommended rate of 6.28 percent rate to be reasonable; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has had an opportunity to review the terms and conditions proposed by the Sponsor for the PILOT agreement and deems them acceptable, subject to approval of the Project by HMFA and approval of the agreement by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, with the final form of the agreement being reviewed by City Council.

WHEREAS, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to extend financial assistance to communities in the elimination or prevention of slums or urban blight, or activities which will benefit low and moderate income persons, or other urgent community development needs; and

WHEREAS, under the HOME Investment Partnerships Program created by the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (NAHA) and amended by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1992, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to extend financial assistance to participating jurisdictions to expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary and affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, under the Emergency Solutions Grants Program contained in the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act of 1987 as amended, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to extend financial assistance to grantees and non-profit agencies which provide essential services, operations, homeless prevention and shelter rehabilitation for homeless or near homeless persons; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has advised the City that FY 2024 allocations are as follows: CDBG \$2,678,757; HOME \$920,383.94; and ESG \$236,263; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton Department of Recreation, Natural Resources, and Culture has prepared an Annual Action Plan for the FY 2024 funding year, being the 5th and final year of the Five-year Consolidated Plan for 2020-2024 period, which assesses the housing needs of extremely low, and moderate income households, homeless families and individuals, and others with special needs; and
